

Radio Earpieces for Motorcycle Testing

RSA

As part of resumption of services, post the COVID 19 cessation, the RSA now require all motorcycle test applicants to bring their own earpiece for communication with Testers during motorcycle tests.

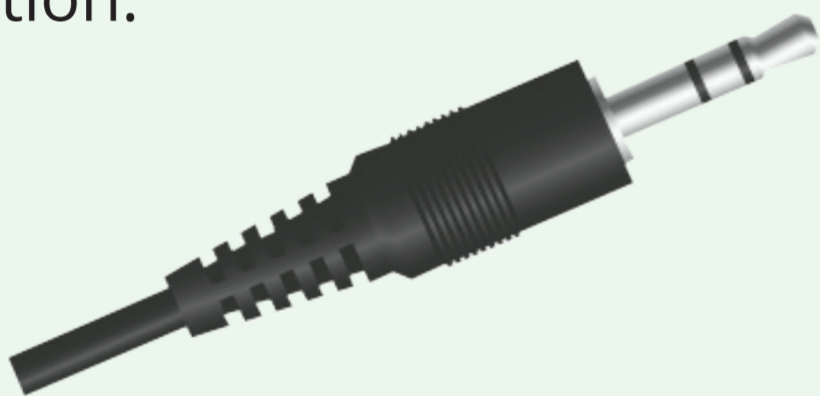


Compatible Earpieces

- Earpiece should have the CE or BS Kite quality standard mark or equivalent.



- Must have a single **3.5mm jack plug** connection.

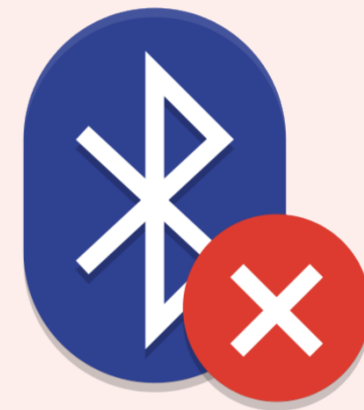


- If using 'in-ear' headphones, you will need to use '**listen only**' headphones. Mobile phone headphones with a built-in microphone may not work with the 1 way 'listen only' radio system used.



Incompatible Earpieces

- RSA Tester radio systems (Motorola CP040) **do not support Bluetooth earpieces** or ear pods.



Buying an Earpiece

- If you do not have a suitable earpiece already your local electronic store or phone accessory shop should have suitable ones available.

Fitting Your Earpiece

- Ensure the earpiece is a comfortable fit when wearing your motorcycle helmet and try it on in advance of your motorcycle test.



Note: Applicants presenting for a motorcycle test with an incompatible earpiece will have to reapply and pay again for a new appointment.
