



## **Notice re Additional Vehicles Requiring Speed Limitation Devices**

In accordance with SI No. 831/2005, the Annual Roadworthiness Test will include checking for a speed limitation device and speed limiter plate (as specified in the SI) on the vehicles listed at the dates specified in the table below (these vehicles are in addition to vehicles already requiring a speed limitation device and speed limiter plate).

Class of Vehicle	Limited Speed km/h	Will be checked on Annual Roadworthiness Test from
Passenger vehicle having a design gross vehicle weight not exceeding 10,000 kilograms first registered after 1 <sup>st</sup> January 2005	100	1 <sup>st</sup> October 2008
Goods vehicle having a design gross vehicle weight exceeding 3,500 kilograms but not exceeding 12,000 kilograms first registered after 1 <sup>st</sup> January 2005	90	1 <sup>st</sup> October 2008
Passenger vehicles with diesel engines having a design gross vehicle weight not exceeding 10,000 kilograms first registered between 1 <sup>st</sup> October 2001 and 31 <sup>st</sup> December 2004	100	1 <sup>st</sup> February 2009
Goods vehicles with diesel engines having a design gross vehicle weight exceeding 3,500 kilograms but not exceeding 12,000 kilograms first registered between 1 <sup>st</sup> October 2001 and 31 <sup>st</sup> December 2004	90	1 <sup>st</sup> February 2009

**Note;** For the purpose of this Regulation, a “passenger vehicle” is defined as “a vehicle having seating accommodation for more than 8 persons exclusive of the driver” and a “goods vehicle” is defined as “a mechanically propelled vehicle, or an articulated vehicle, constructed or adapted primarily for the conveyance of goods or burden of any description”.
