**To all Vehicle Testing Authorised Officers and Authorised HGV Test Centres**

**Roadworthiness Testing of Campers and Motor homes – Speed Limiter**

In light of recent feedback regarding the testing of camper vans and motor caravans, the RSA plan to conduct a review of specific testing procedures for these vehicles. Pending the result of this review, a **temporary exemption** is granted for the test requirement for Speed Limitation devices on campers and motor caravans of DGVW over 3500 kg.

Consequently, on the roadworthiness test a camper or motor home should not be failed if it does not have a speed limitation device. However where a speed limitation device is fitted it should be tested.
