To all Vehicle Testing Authorised Officers and LGV Authorised Test Centres:

Requirement for weigh docket for LGV Testing

As per Circular VS 24/04 of 23rd December 2004, the presented weight is now used to calculate brake performance for all LGV's and because of this, there is no longer a need to establish the unladen weight (ULW) of the vehicle. Therefore from the date of this circular, there will no longer a requirement for a weigh docket to be presented when an LGV is being presented for testing.

Subsequent to Circular Letter VS 21/04, there will no longer be a requirement to enter the vehicle ULW when issuing a Pass Statement.
