## Who do I contact to change the ownership on a vehicle?

- If your vehicle was registered *before* 01 January 1993 contact your local motor tax office.
- If your vehicle was registered *after* 01 January 1993 contact [DVCSD](#) in Shannon or email [motortax@dtas.ie](mailto:motortax@dtas.ie)

## Who do I contact to amend vehicle registration certificate (VRC)?

For all queries in relation to amending a VRC or Log Book contact your local [motor tax office](#).

## Can I get a VIN No. and build date for a car I purchased in Ireland and imported into the UK as it had no chassis plate with a VIN No. or documentation with it and the original seller will not furnish it?

You can email [motortax@dtas.ie](mailto:motortax@dtas.ie) the driver and vehicle computer services division (DVCSD) in Shannon who have responsibility for the national vehicle and driver file (NVDF) containing details of all vehicles registered in Ireland.

## My vehicle was recently repaired following a crash. In order to sell it on do I need a certificate of roadworthiness?
