Introduction

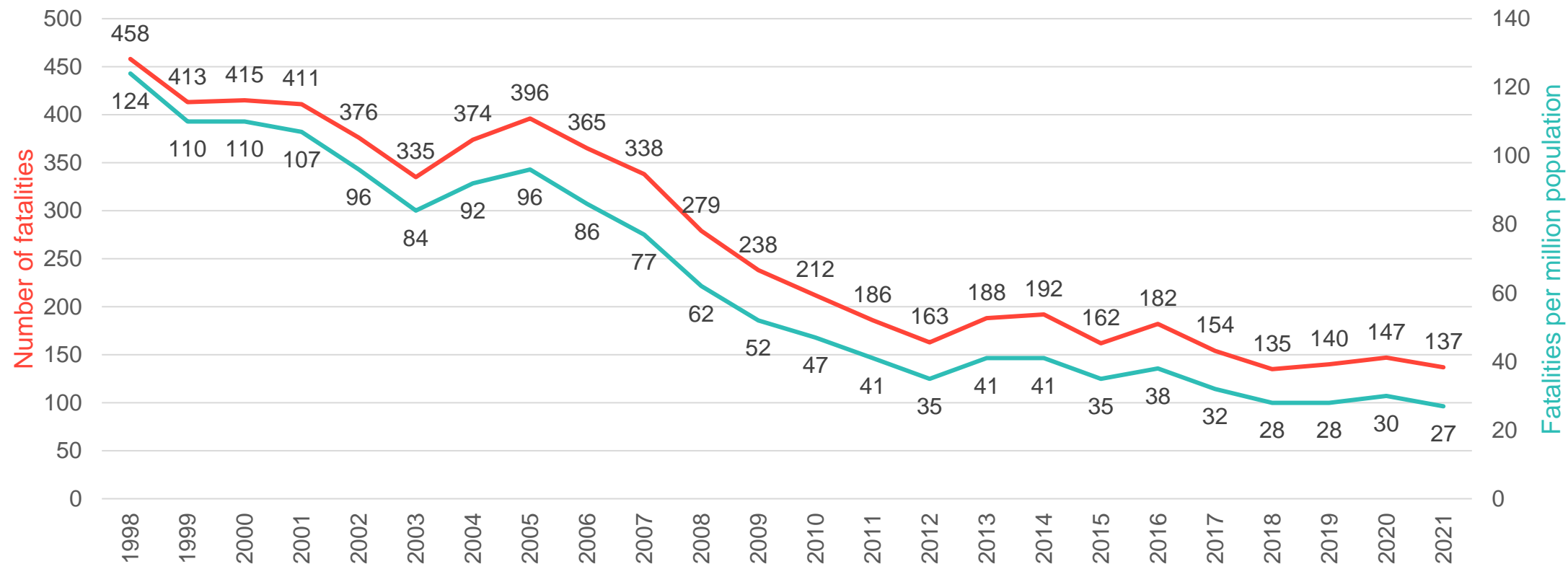
- The data in this report is based on preliminary reports from An Garda Síochána, based on information current as of **10 June 2022**.

1998-2021



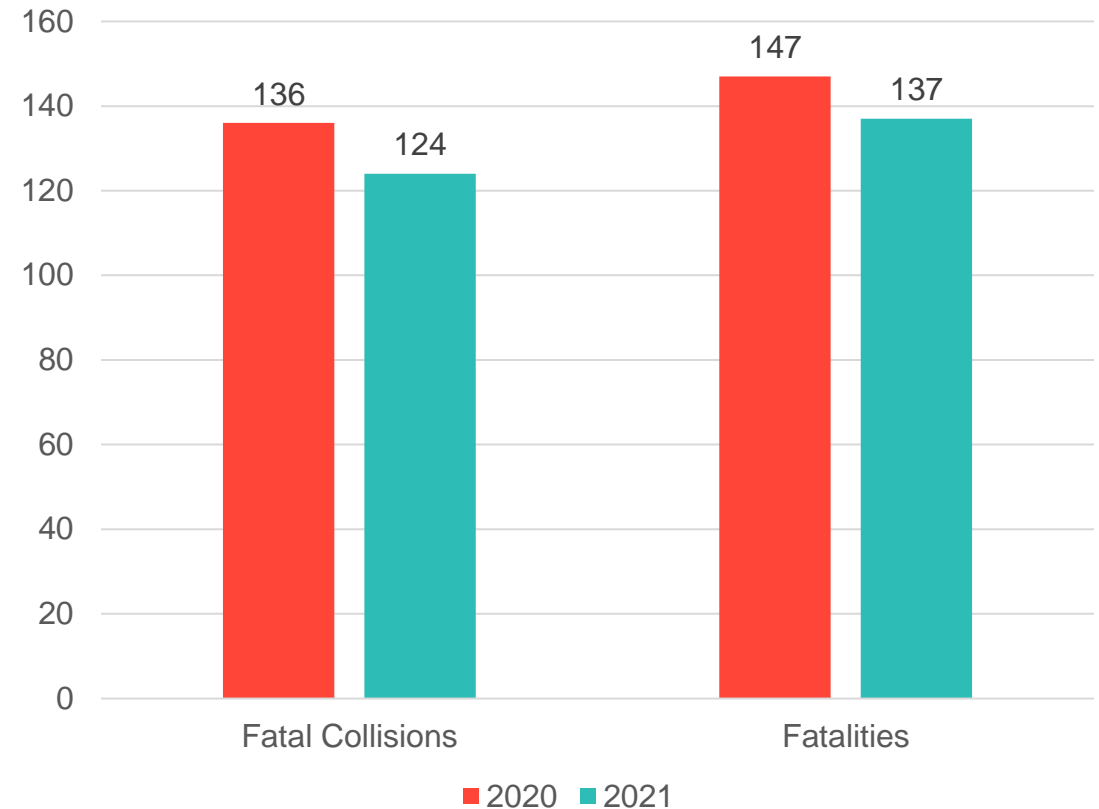

Fatalities

2020 and 2021

- As of 31 December 2021, there have been **124** fatal collisions, which have resulted in **137** fatalities on Irish roads.
- This represents **12 less** fatal collisions and **10 less** deaths **(-7%)** compared to provisional Garda data for 2020.



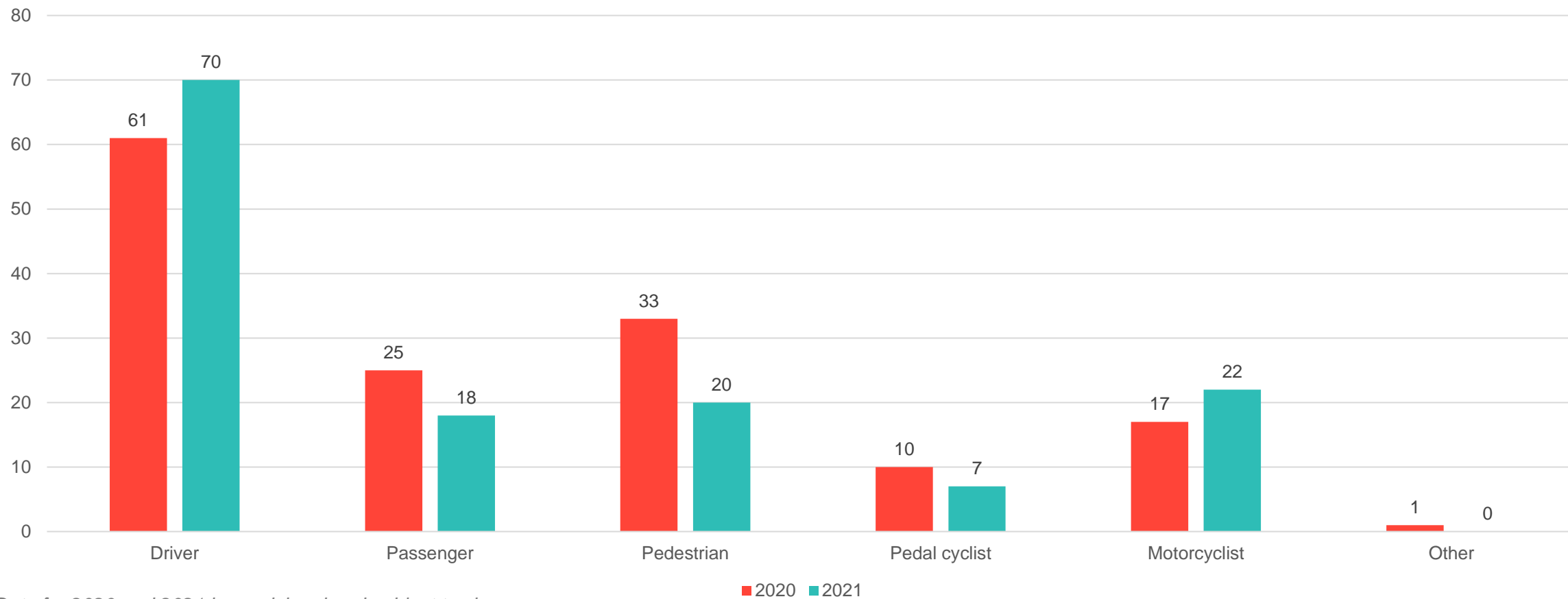

2020 and 2021



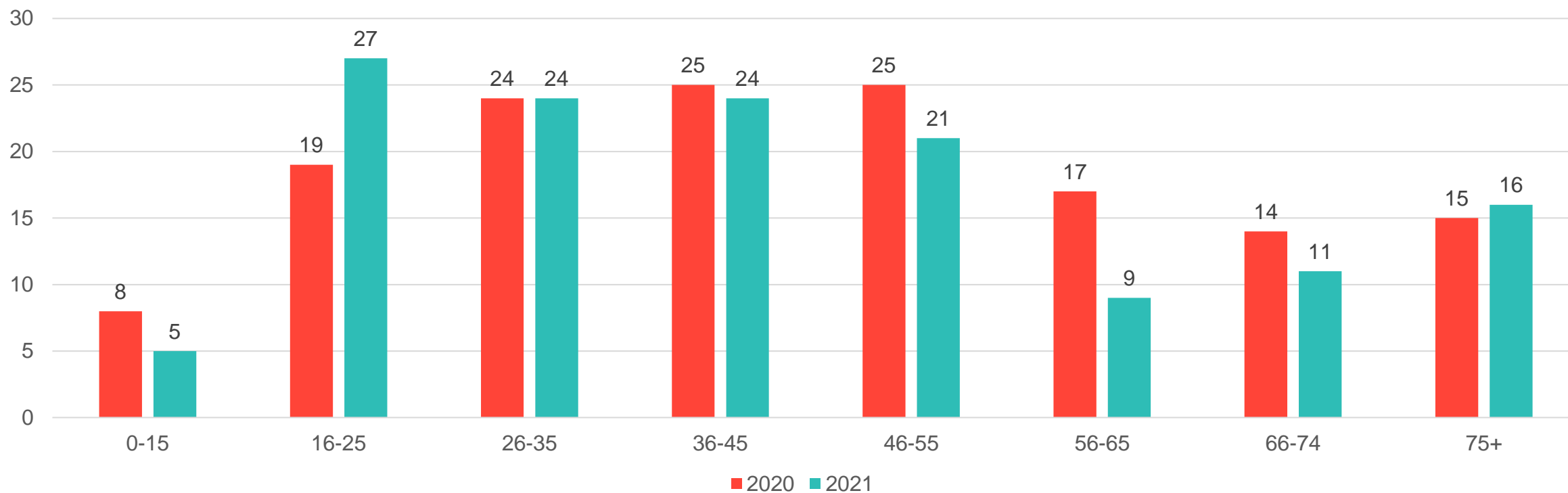
