

LAW

Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act 2010

Member of An Garda Síochána not below rank of Inspector provides written authorisation for date, time & specific location

Allows Gardaí conducting checkpoint to stop any vehicle and require driver to:

- Provide Breath Specimen
- Provide Oral Fluid Specimen
- others incl, indicate how to provide sample, move vehicle, accompany to location.

If person, without reasonable excuse, fails or refuses to, comply with above requirements – they commit offence, Garda has power of arrest




