



Where to find and how to identify a vehicle's sound level approval number

When making an end-of-series application under the upcoming noise regulations, you will need to enter the sound level approval number of each vehicle in the vehicle excel spreadsheet. This may not appear on the vehicle's CoC, therefore you will need to contact the factory/homologation department in order to get this number.

The table below gives an example of both Phase 1 and Phase 2 sound level approval numbers. **To Note** The numbers used are fictitious. Any resemblance to actual vehicle type-approval numbers and sound level approval numbers is purely coincidental.

Example 1	e4*2007/46*24l9*01	e9*540/2014* <mark>A</mark> 000148	E9 51R- <mark>02</mark> 0148	Loses its validity from 1 July 2022
Example 2	e9*2018/858*0I48*00	e4*540/2014* B 002439	E4 51R- <mark>03</mark> 2439	Continues to remain valid.

- If a vehicle meets the phase 1 limit values only, section 3 of the type-approval number is followed by the Character A, or has an approval to R51.02, this loses its validity from 1 July 2022.
- If a vehicle meets the phase 2 limit values, section 3 of the type-approval number is followed by the Character 'B' or has an approval to R51.03. This continues to remain valid.
