

Covid-19 Driving Test Customer Information

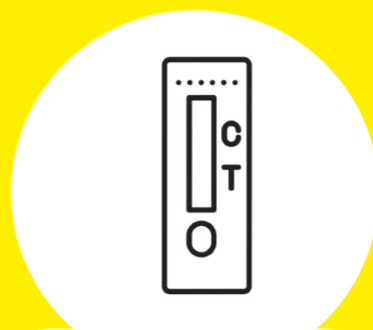

You must follow these Covid-19 driving test guidelines, or your test will not go ahead

Before your test

Antigen test

You must take a covid-19 antigen test within 24 hours of your driving test. If you haven't taken an antigen test or have a positive result, you must reschedule your test.



Manage my booking

Symptoms and close contacts

If you have covid-19 symptoms or are a close contact, cancel your test. You will be sent a new invitation to rebook your test for free.



Manage my booking

Clean your vehicle

Clean your test vehicle and remove all personal items from it.



Ventilate your vehicle

Ensure all the windows in your vehicle are partly open to allow air flow.



Wear suitable clothing

Windows must remain open during your test so wear suitable clothing to allow for this.



Wear your mask correctly

Ensure your nose and mouth are covered by your mask. If you will be wearing glasses, find a suitable way to prevent them from fogging. Wear your mask correctly so that your test can go ahead.



Follow guidance

Ensure you adhere to the latest public-health guidance.

At the driving test centre

Access to test centres

Only applicants can enter the driving test centre.



Pre-test calls

Your driver tester will call you at the time of your test. Make sure your mobile phone is switched on and its settings allow calls from a private number.



Answer screening questions

You will be asked some questions to protect you and your tester. It is important you answer these truthfully and honestly.



Sanitise your hands

You must wash or sanitise your hands before and after your test.



Wear mask provided

You will be given a surgical face mask and you **must** wear it.



Dispose of your mask

After your test, place your used face mask safely in the bins provided.



On occasion there may be a third person in the vehicle to supervise the test, this will meet all the necessary Covid-19 requirements.

Note: We may share your contact information (name and phone number) with the National Covid-19 Contact-Tracing Programme if the Public Health Authorities ask us to.
