Before your test

Follow guidance

Ensure you adhere to the latest public-health guidance.



Covid-19 and symptoms

If you have covid-19 or covid-19 symptoms cancel your test. You will be sent a new invitation to rebook your test for free.

Clean your vehicle

Clean your test vehicle and remove all personal items from it.



Ventilate your vehicle

So that your test can go ahead ensure all the windows in your vehicle are partly open to allow air flow.



Wear suitable clothing

Windows must remain open during your test so wear suitable clothing to allow for this.



Wear your mask correctly

Ensure your nose and mouth are covered by your mask. If you will be wearing glasses, find a suitable way to prevent them from fogging.



At the driving test centre

Access to test centres

Driving test centres are gradually re-opening for public access. Follow guidance at your test centre or see full listings on rsa.ie under covid-19-services-update.



Pre-test calls

Your driver tester will call you at the time of your test. Make sure your mobile phone is switched on and its settings allow calls from a private number.



Answer screening questions

You will be asked some questions to protect you and your tester. It is important you answer these truthfully and honestly.



Sanitise your hands

You must wash or sanitise your hands before and after your test.



Please wear a mask

Wearing of mask or face covering is still strongly recommended. You can either wear your own mask or face covering or one will be available for you.



Dispose of your mask

After your test, place your used disposal face mask safely in the bins provided.



On occasion there may be a third person in the vehicle to supervise the test, this will meet all the necessary Covid-19 requirements.
