

Driving test scheduling principles

How we manage driving test applications

- In the interest of fairness, driving test appointment invitations will be issued in the following order:
 - 1. Critical frontline workers: priority customers whose request as a <u>critical frontline worker</u> has been accepted.
 - 2. Re-tests: customers who have failed their test and reapplied. There's a minimum six-week gap between failing your test and being invited for a retest.
 - 3. Eligibility and application date: the earlier a customer applied, the sooner they will get an appointment, provided they were <u>eligible to sit a test</u> at the time they applied.
- Customers invited to book a test have 10 days to select an appointment. If they're not ready to sit a test, they can hold off booking and re-add themselves to the invitation queue at a later stage.
