## RSA ADI APPLICATION PROCESS - NOTES

The following notes should be read before completing the application form

### What is a RSA ADI certification?

The Road Safety Authority (RSA) has been asked to regulate those working in the driving instruction industry. Driving instructors who meet the standard set by the RSA will become Approved Driving Instructor (ADI) and receive a FETAC specific purpose award for driving instruction. The objective of regulating the industry is to standardise instruction and give the ADI instructor a leading role in developing better drivers. The conditions of membership have been carefully framed to allow for a quality standard to be met with the minimum of inconvenience to the applicant.

### Question 1 - 4

Please fill in the information in capitals, clearly and correctly.

Please provide details of contact telephone numbers at which the RSA may contact you. Contact will include group text messages by way of an alert from time to time

To qualify to participate in the three stage examination process you must be the holder of a full drivers licence in the category you wish to give instruction, for a minimum of 2 years at time of application. Insert the date of issue of your first full driving licence.

### Question 13

An RSA ADI must hold a drivers licence in the category in which they want to give instruction.

You must complete a theory test for each category and a driving test in each group of categories (see Approved Driving Instructor Information Booklet p.12).

The ADI Unit will advise which Stage 2 Driving tests need to be carried out depending on the categories of instruction for which you are seeking approval. Information provided in the ADI Information booklet will help you determine what tests will be necessary.

The Instruction ability test may be completed in any of the categories you have applied for.

#### Question 14

You may request to have your qualifying examinations conducted through the Irish language. If you wish to do so, indicate which stages you would like conducted through Irish.

The theory test provider Prometric Ireland Ltd. should be contacted regarding the date, time and location of your theory test. These details will be clearly outlined in an email which will issue to you once your Garda vetting information has been received from An Garda Síochána.

Stage two– driving test and stage three – instruction ability test will be held in the locations outlined in question 16.

#### Recognition of Existing Qualifications

Please see in your information pack what is required by the RSA to assess your existing qualification. Please also note the standards of service providers, quality assurances in place by the RSA. You should contact the ADI Unit in relation to recognition of prior qualifications. An assessment will only be made once you submit your application form and all required documentation and you will be notified of the outcome.

#### Fee:

Once you make a completed application to the Road Safety Authority (see checklist below) to become an ADI and your Garda vetting application has been processed and approved (Please note that this can take approximately 6 – 8 weeks) you will receive an email containing an eligibility number and the details on how to book your ADI Stage 1 Theory Test by telephone or online. It is at this stage that you will make payment for ADI Stage 1 Theory Test directly to Prometric (company that you will book your ADI theory test with). This fee is currently €150.

#### Cancelling your test:

##### Important

Please note 10 clear working days notice of cancellation must be given, otherwise the examination fee is forfeit. A limit of two cancellations (within the 10 days period) applies to each stage of the examination process after which any fee will be forfeit.
